The Cost of Running the Best School!

At last night's PTO Meeting, our School Board President, Gerry Obluda, spoke about the process utilized by all Diocesan schools at this time of year in order to determine Tuition Rates for the upcoming year. Analyses of past expenses as well as projected enrollments all contribute to the formulation of the tuition rates needed to maintain our fine school and all it offers our students. The new annex added new challenges as funding to cover the monthly loan payments also needed to be accounted for. To accomplish this financial obligation, the School Board determined that a \$200 per family Building Fee would be assessed. Building on Tradition fund raising also continues to generate funds in order to wipe out the owed principal as soon as possible. The School Board believes our families desire that our school maintain its high standards and level of accomplishments by funding its dedicated faculty and staff, challenging curriculums, limited class sizes, and quality enrichment programs. All of which are involved in making the best school, *ICCS*, run!
