

Summer Learning Bingo Challenge

3rd Grade Ideas

Independence

- Practice responsibility through simple chores at home
- Organize personal belongings and clean up independently
- Memorize family phone numbers and home address
- Practice solving small problems independently before asking for help
- Practice time awareness (morning routines, getting ready, helping pack belongings)

Math

- Practice addition and subtraction facts with fluency
- Count by 2s, 5s, 10s, and 100s
- Begin practicing skip counting to prepare for multiplication
- Add and subtract using real-life situations (money, cooking, grocery shopping, measuring, etc.)
- Solve simple word problems together
- Find and complete number patterns
- Example: 125, 135, __, 155
- Example: 6, 12, __, 24
- Play games that build math thinking (Uno, Yahtzee Jr., card games, dominoes, Monopoly Junior, etc.)

Social Emotional Skills

- Allow time for unstructured play (and even boredom!) to encourage creativity, independence, and problem-solving
- Talk through friendship challenges and brainstorm respectful solutions
- Encourage good sportsmanship, responsibility, and kindness

Reading & Literacy

- Practice spelling and complete sentence by writing letters to friends and family
- Practice reading aloud smoothly
- Retell stories using beginning, middle, and end, including important details

Our Faith

- Practice daily prayers: Blessing Before Meals, Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be, and Guardian Angel Prayer
- Try praying a decade of the Rosary together
- Attend Mass regularly and discuss the readings or homily afterward
